- Staying home with a temperature of 100 degrees or higher and remaining home 24 hours fever-free without the aid of fever-reducing medication.

Although the focus has been on the H1N1 virus, please do not forget that this is the time of year for the seasonal flu to make its appearance. It is critical that we remain conscientious with our respiratory hygiene. Please continue to reinforce these precautions with your children.
